Two more classes are being offered this term: O.T. survey and Doctrines 2. The videos, assignments, quizzes, and tests for each of these classes are almost complete. Please continue to pray for us as we continue to prepare these materials.

For at least the near future, each term will introduce at least one new teacher to the students and to the process of teaching online. It has been my ...pleasure (I think that is the word I want to use) to guide students in learning to use their electronic devices to study the Word of God. It is also my...pleasure to help teachers along in this process as well. I am very thankful for the missionaries and Cambodian pastors that are volunteering and puting in the work to teach in this institute. They are a huge blessing. Lord willing, we will be able to have a "training" retreat for all of these teachers sometime within the next year. Those who have already taught can give testimony of what they did wrong so as to help others not to repeat their mistakes. :) Please pray for God to give us all wisdom in this endeavor, and also pray that this retreat will happen according to God's will.
