I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to share both some **blessings and realities** concerning our mission to bring the Word of God to the people of Mongolia.

Firstly, we have been immensely blessed with several gifts for the ministry. Recently we received a **generous donation from a church in Michigan: a computer** that aligns perfectly with the specifications we were seeking for our ministry. A few weeks later, a man in Tennessee blessed us with **a gift of \$10,000 to purchase a color digital press in Mongolia** and then while we were in a mission conference in Virginia, the church took up a **\$35,000 offering to purchase a two-color press to be used for the printing of**



Gods word in Mongolia. All these machines will serve as invaluable tools in our endeavor to provide the people of Mongolia with access to the complete Bible, with the Old Testament translation expected to be **completed**



within the next two years.

However, amidst these blessings, we also face the **reality of needing additional support**. In order to make the equipment operational, we need **\$15,000 to construct a suitable room** and prepare it for the arrival of the presses. Additionally included in the amount is the **cost of our travel to Mongolia**, with our **departure planned within the next two weeks**.

I am reaching out to **humbly ask you for your assistance in meeting these needs.** We have two churches that have committed \$2,500 toward this need. As stated in Philippians 4:17, our desire is *not merely to receive gifts, but to see the fruit that abounds to your*

account through the impact of this equipment in spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the forgotten Mongolian people.

Your support, whether through financial contributions or prayers, is invaluable to us as we work towards this noble cause. **Together**, we can **make a tangible difference** in the lives of the forgotten people of Mongolia, **bringing them the light of God's Word**.
