May 2024 Prayer Letter

Dear Prayer Warriors,

We are once again thankful for God's goodness as we saw Him work during this past month of May. We were privileged to lead four people to Christ this month as we continue to work through our language training courses. We were also able to join the Miller family in Querétaro/Santa Rosa Jáuregui (a northern suburb) for their charter service on May 5. We enjoyed also spending some more time sightseeing in and learning about Querétaro.

The month of May is normally the hottest month of the year in Mexico, and it seems that this May was no exception. We saw temperatures as high 101°F/38°C in Irapuato, and from what we have heard, this is hotter than the normal for hot season. Per Weather.com, temperatures were as high as 15°F/9°C above average. We are extremely grateful that the Lord touched some hearts such that there were some individuals who gave so we could have some portable air conditioners to use at night so we can all get some better sleep. We should be entering rainy season soon, so that should bring some relief from the heat with it.

Regarding our kitchen situation, we are still waiting to hear back from the home's owner regarding responsibility for the repair. Should we need to foot the bill for kitchen repairs, it could cost as much as \$2,000-\$3,000 USD for the cabinetry repairs, glass replacement, and a new stove. Regardless of who is responsible financially for the repairs, it seems likely that we will have to spend about \$1,100-\$1,400 to purchase a trustworthy stove for our time here in Irapuato. Please join us in praying that God would provide what funds prove to be necessary for the scenario that does come to pass. Thank you again for your prayers regarding this situation, and I hope to tell you all that our kitchen situation is resolved soon.
