## 2024 Year-to-Date Fires

In July we had a good Fires conference in Belize where 150 attended at night and 15 souls were saved. The very next week we had a conference in the Dominican Republic with Bro. José Agüero. There were 62 pastors present and 28 brethren surrendered their lives to serve the Lord full-time.

Then in August we had our largest conference of the year. It was held in Mexico City. Over 8000 attended the evening services among which were 650 pastors, assistant pastors, and missionaries from all over Mexico, Chile, Argentina, Bolivia and even Cuba and Venezuela. There were hundreds of folks saved during the week.

We have two Fires conferences in September. One will be in Bogota, Colombia (9/16-19), and the other in Santa Ana, El Salvador (9/23-25).

## Prayer Needs

Pray for Robin and me as we participate in a missions conference in Kingsport, TN (9/1) and conduct that special meeting in Birmingham in September (9/15). Pray that God will continue to give us opportunities to give the gospel as we did to Berta from Honduras the other Saturday. She was ripe fruit. We now seek to follow-up with her to see her follow after the Lord.

Another special need is to replace our vehicles. One has over 212,000 miles, while the other has over 310,000. We have been trusting the Lord to keep these going without overburdening repair bills.

After being transported to the Cleveland Clinic and receiving more focused care, he has recovered sufficiently to be relocated to a rehab center in Canton. Continue to pray for him. The following weekend Robin and I went to Birmingham, AL, where we did a clinic on the family and marriage in a Spanish-speaking ministry. The Lord blessed, good was accomplished, and important decisions were made. The English pastor has asked us to come back in September to do a special English-Spanish combined service, which we plan to do on Sept. 15th. This will take some trusting in the Lord to preach a message in two languages at the same time.
