We hope to be moved to Tegucigalpa by May and, God willing, the first church plant will be holding services by June or July.



Before we left Honduras we took a trip to Tegucigalpa and spent several days there visiting different areas and getting a better feel for the city. We have both spent time there in the past, but not from the perspective of looking for church locations or a neighborhood to live in. It was too much to complete in the time we had, but we did narrow down what areas we want to investigate further. We also took the time to relax a bit as a family to celebrate finishing language school.

The girls are doing pretty good adjusting to traveling around the States. Sofia was trying to speak in Spanish to everyone at first, but I think she's happy to have learned that she can speak in English here. She has definitely adopted the culture of Honduras as well, because she makes a point of saying hello to everyone around us at every hotel breakfast. Rosie has started to celebrate getting out of her car seat each travel day by walking around wherever we are staying, although she hasn't really figured out the brakes yet. Please pray that she doesn't get too many bumps on her head.

Would you also pray that God would continue to increase our support to 100 percent? We are currently at around 90% of our support and just had a church take us on last week! We are trusting that God will provide the remainder of our support and thank you for your prayers.
