We thank you for that! Your prayers and support have helped us these past two months, and they continue to strengthen us.

On Tuesday before Thanksgiving, Nicole's mother (Linda Davidson a.k.a. Nana) suffered a brain bleed. Nana was placed on hospice. She passed away eleven days later on December 8, 2024. We thank the

Lord that we had the privilege to minister to her these last three years and that we could be with her as she slipped into the



presence of her Savior. Nana had a deep faith in her Lord, which made it easier for me to officiate her funeral and graveside service.

Four days later, Nicole's uncle (Eddie Samples) passed away. He too loved the Lord Jesus. I was also honored to preach his graveside service. Please continue to pray for Nicole as she grieves her beloved mother and her Uncle Eddie.

In the middle of all of this, my 90 year old mother (Mary Yingling) suffered two compression fractures in her back. Shortly after a procedure meant to alleviate her back pain, she came down with COVID. This led to her hospitalization. She has been in the hospital now for al-

most two weeks. The COVID has passed, but it has affected her kidneys, her lungs and her heart. We spend several hours everyday with her at the hospital. Our goal is to get her to a rehabilitation center soon. Please pray for my mom, and please pray for us as we care for her during a very busy month at BIO. January is the month that all of our missionary 1099s must be processed and printed.

Last month our daughter, Amber Yingling, announced her engagement to Jonell Gonzales. I first met Jonell at his church when I preached for the BIO Philippines conference last January. It has been exciting to watch God bring two faithful servants together so that they may accomplish even more for His glory. Nicole and I plan to travel to the Philippines this April for the wedding. I have also been asked to speak for the BIO Philippines conference again as they celebrate their 25th anniversary (April 29 - May 1). Your prayers and your gifts toward this trip would be a great blessing. The tickets alone cost us right at \$3,000.

Nicole and I look forward to visiting two of our grandbabies who live in Florida at the end of February. It is very fortunate that they live very close to Avon Park Correctional Facility where I have been planning a two day Bible conference. We plan to go through the Book of Colossians with the inmates. The theme for the conference will be *The Preeminent Christ.* Please pray for this special conference with the church inside this prison.
