Cuba: A Fresh Perspective on God's Work

Just last week, I had the incredible opportunity to travel to Cuba and spend time with some of the national pastors there. To say it was an eye-opening experience would be an understatement. Despite the many challenges the people of Cuba face—politically, economically, and spiritually—the Gospel is spreading like wildfire.

One pastor I met shared that, over the past 25 years, he and his family have planted 15 churches! That is absolutely amazing. Imagine the amount of faith, perseverance, and sacrifice it takes to do that in a country where resources are scarce, churches face restrictions, and daily life is filled with uncertainty. Yet, these faithful men press forward, fully trusting God to provide and open doors.

One of the most humbling things about this trip was witnessing the determination of the pastors and their congregations. They have so little compared to what we are used to, yet their faith is strong, their worship is sincere, and their passion for reaching the lost is unwavering. They are not discouraged by the obstacles in their path—instead, they are strengthened by them.

Through CORE Missions, we were able to provide financial support, theological training, and accountability to these pastors, helping them continue their ministries. But there is still so much more to be done! Please pray for these men as they serve in difficult conditions. Pray for their families, their churches, their protection, and their ability to continue sharing the Gospel in such a closed country.

Looking Ahead to 2025

We are excited to see what God has in store for this new year! Our schedule for 2025 is already filling up, and we are trusting the Lord to guide us to the churches He wants us to be in. We still have a few open dates and are praying that God will fill those spots with churches who have a heart for missions and a desire to partner with CORE Missions.

One of our biggest goals this year is to continue raising support for our family so that we can remain fully engaged in this ministry. We're also praying that more churches will take on national pastors for support. Every dollar given to a national pastor goes directly to helping him reach his community with the Gospel. These men are doing incredible work, and it's a blessing to see how far even a small investment can go in supporting their ministries.
