Dear Friends and Partners,

We have a story that we beleive you'll find fascinating (you honestly can't make stuff like this up). The last couple of weeks, we were in Bolivia, seeking opportunities to expand our ministry and scouting potential properties for a future camp. While there, we set out to visit a site that had incredible promise... beautiful land, plenty of space, and a strategic location. We are very excited about the possibilities this location offers, but little did we know that God had something even more unexpected in store for us that day.

As we explored the first property, we quickly realized that while it wasn't quite spacious enough for a full-scale camp, it had tremendous potential for another purpose. The site already had an auditorium, housing for a family, and ample space for classrooms... making it an ideal location for a church. Not only that, but it would also be a perfect place to host mission teams or short term missionaries, creating a hub for ministry outreach in the region. Even though it wasn't what we originally had in mind, we cannot ignore the possibilities and are exploring various options.

While on the trip to this location, a pastor friend traveling with us shared a shocking story. He told us about another pastor in Bolivia who had taken a loan from a dubious source to help finance a portion of his church building. Unfortunately, he had fallen behind on payments, and the lenders weren't exactly the kind to send polite reminders. Now, he was receiving terrifying threats... either he pay up, or they would kill him or kidnap one of his children as collateral. We've heard of desperate financial decisions before, but this was unlike anything we'd ever encountered.

Completely out of options and fearing for his family, the pastor made a desperate offer... he is willing to sign over his entire property, including a church building that seats 200 people, in exchange for his freedom and safety. Our pastor friend was stunned as were we. However, we immediately saw both the urgency of the situation and the incredible opportunity before us.

Naturally, we went to see the property. As we stood there, looking at what could become a thriving church, we couldn't help but marvel at how God moves in unexpected ways. What began as a routine trip to evaluate land for a camp turned into a possible divine appointment... an open door to establish two churches in places where the Gospel is desperately needed.

This experience was a powerful reminder that when we step out in faith, God often leads us to opportunities we never imagined. It also reinforced why we do what we do and why your support matters. Every day, there are people crying out for hope, for safety, for the Good News of Jesus Christ. And through your prayers and generosity, we can be there to meet them in their moment of need.
