The conference was held nearby from where he was stationed during his time in the military. Shortly after arriving home from Kansas (multiple flight cancellations on his way home), Paul headed to Virginia to speak about MASH Ministries. November for sure felt like a whirlwind but thankful for safety in traveling. We are hoping the never-ending cough will leave the house soon. Alyssa had bronchitis almost pneumonia for a week and still has the lingering cough that has decided to stay. The rest of the girls also have this cough. Hoping the extra rest over Christmas will help them and maybe one day the girls won't be woken up in the night from coughing.

The support groups continue to grow and those in attendance regularly attend and are engaged in the discussions. We look forward to seeing how the support groups will grow this upcoming year.

We enjoyed watching the girls perform in their concerts on Sunday and yesterday at school. We look forward to celebrating Christ's birth with family and are excited to see what is in store for 2025.
